How to Graduate in the School of Holiness

Principle 5: Make a Covenant with Your Eyes By Rev. Sergio Scataglini



Job 31:1 (NIV) states "I made a covenant

with my eyes not to look lustfully at a girl."

Still today we need to make a covenant with our eyes. Many of the problems in the church begins with our eyes—the desires of the flesh and the lust of our eyes.

This is the will of God: that you make a covenant and say, "Eyes of mine, from this day on, you will not look with lust or greed at anyone. You are going to function in absolute purity."

It was the Reformer, Martin Luther, who said ,

"You cannot keep the birds from flying over your head, but you can keep them from making a nest in your hair."

A few years ago, we were in the beautiful city of Mar del Plata, Argentina. I took my three boys for a walk. Soon we passed a huge billboard with a semi-naked and very provocative woman on it. One of my boys

was especially attracted to that sign—he could not take his eyes off of it.

I made the comment, "Boys, it looks like the lady needs more money for clothes, huh?!"—

trying to make the moment light. I noticed automatically my feet began to walk faster trying to get the kids out of there. I then decided to make it a training moment.

I said, "Boys, I know you are small children, but **I want to teach you the Principle of the Second Second.** The first second, none of us could avoid. We were just walking and happened to see it, but the second second is ours. We can choose to turn our eyes to something else."

Friend, the same principle I taught to my children, with the grace of God, I apply to my life and I want to teach it to

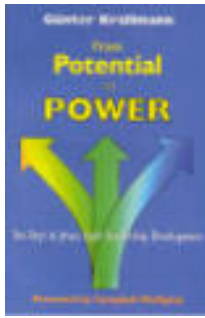

every servant of the Lord.

The way to stay away from lust is not to give one extra second of your time or attention to it. You will need to make a covenant with your eyes.

I have been in public places where it is easy to be distracted. I have looked one second too long at ungodly things and have knelt down publicly, right there, and said "God Almighty, purify me! I betrayed You for one second. Give me eyes that would be as pure as the eyes of Jesus. Take me home, Lord, rather than to let me fall in sin. Help me to live a righteous life."

Some people ask, "How can we

live in this holiness?" It is very simple. I Thessalonians 5:24 says we should be "blameless", and goes on to say that "the one who calls you is faithful and *He will do it*" (emphasis mine).

Some people believe that salvation is by faith, but holiness is by works. The good news is: salvation is by faith, and holiness is also by faith.

In 1 Corinthians 1:30 we read that Jesus Christ was made for us not only salvation, but also sanctification. We Christians need to believe this. If we are going to preach this gospel to the lost, we may as well believe it ourselves and enjoy living a holy life. □
