How to Graduate in the School of Holiness

Principle 5: Use Discernment

All the violence in America, from road rage to school shootings, is a reminder to the people of God that violence as entertainment is sin.

Some Christians live without discernment. They watch movies and if it has sexual immorality, they change the channel. Instead, they change to watch violence, and think it is a better choice.

Proverbs 11:17 says, "The merciful man does

good to his own soul, but he who is cruel troubles his own flesh." An invasion of violence has come to America, and the church needs to stand strong.

The person that has lost compassion, that is cruel to animals or to people, has been desensitized. Lev 10:10 says, "You must distinguish between the holy and the common, between the clean and the unclean."

PROVERBS 12:10: A RIGHTEOUS MAN REGARDS THE LIFE OF HIS ANIMAL, BUT THE TENDER MERCIES OF THE WICKED ARE CRUEL.

You and I, as people of God, are called to make a clear distinction between right and wrong, between a good action movie and a blatantly cruel one. The

Lord will give us discernment. (See Heb. 5:15, Ez. 44:23, Is. 57:8 on discernment.)

Some Christians struggle with a spirit of anger. Friend, if we live in rage, it is a sign that we need an encounter with God. Uncontrolled anger is a sign that our lives are in spiritual decay. God wants to set us free from rage. If we are violent--if we have fits of rage at home, if we insult and hate people, if we have not forgiven others -- there is something wrong with our hearts.

Throughout my own life, perhaps the greatest temptation has been to harbor resentment, unforgiveness, and hatred. I come from a land of tremendous violence--not at home, but at school and in (continued, p.2)

the streets. When I was a teenager, Argentina went through a guerilla war. I did not realize the impact of the environment on my soul.

It is very easy to become influenced by our social environment. Thus, it is important to be careful of what we watch as entertainment. I rejected the sin of the culture, but something in my heart was accepting the iniquity (residual sin in the culture) of violence.

I remember my days in High School. Everyday I got into a fist fight, until I truly committed my life to the Lord. I was a Christian, but a fighting Christian. However, when I was 15 years old, a preacher began to talk about holiness and about dy-

ing for Jesus. "Those who want to be a martyr, come to the front." I had made up my mind that I would not go to the front during that altar call, but before the meeting was over, I was trembling and walking to the front. I returned to the school after that commitment to the Lord and was a changed person. I began to evangelize. I had no more fights and no more aggressions.

God is calling many of us to pay a price that we did not believe we could to live a life of holiness. Are we willing to answer the call to set aside all rage, malice, furious reactions and hurting words? Nothing can prevent us from being completely holy and meek--from becoming more like Jesus each day. □
